

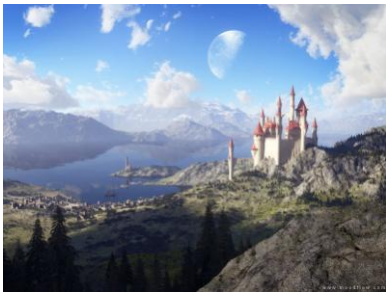

Summer 2010 Junior Kindergarten and Elementary Preparation Programs

Fairy Tale Fun and Fantasies

Broomfield Academy is pleased to offer individualized and advanced Junior Kindergarten and Elementary Preparation programming on a year-round basis. Junior Kindergarten, for children ages 3-4 provides a structured and age-appropriate academic and arts based program, along with great summer fun. Elementary Prep, for children age 5-6, is an academic program for families who desire a balance of intensive core academic work and plenty of summer fun for their children in preparation for Kindergarten or 1st grade in the fall.



The 2009-2010 school year ends on May 28, 2010. The summer program starts the following week and will run for nine weeks, from June 3-August 6, 2010. Junior Kindergarten and Elementary Prep students are welcome to attend the Broomfield Academy Summer Enrichment Camp, if desired, on June 3, June 4, August 9 and August 10.

Summer options include 2, 3 or 5-day a week schedules. ***Space is limited.*** Please contact Anica McFarlane, the School Administrator, in the front office for a summer or 2010-2011 school year contract. Tuition for the summer program is charged at the 2010-2011 tuition rates. Families in the summer program who continue at Broomfield Academy in the fall receive the last week of our summer programming at no additional cost.

Summer Junior Kindergarten and Elementary Preparation Program (flexible / ages 3-6)

This program provides a balanced approach to learning during the summer months. Students participate in structured indoor and outdoor activities. In a typical day, students will be joining the teacher for guided language arts and basic phonics activities, as well as mathematics. Science during the summer months will focus on outdoor activities including gardening, studying wildlife, and enjoying our learning tables for water play. Students in the Junior Kindergarten program will continue with a rest period after lunch throughout the summer. Children in our Elementary Preparation program will quickly phase

out the rest periods during the summer months to prepare for full-time Kindergarten or First Grade in the fall. All children are allowed to participate in quiet literacy or art activities if they are unable to rest. Children continue to enjoy weekly rotating themes and/or field trip activities which may include pottery or art based projects, local library visits, and reading activities with older students in our summer camp program.

***Tentative Typical Junior Kindergarten and Elementary Preparation Schedule**

Our program begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 3:30 p.m. daily, Monday - Friday. At 3:30 p.m., children are picked up by their parents or move to the summer camp/extended day programming with our older students. **Extended day programming is available from 7:00-8:30 a.m. and from 3:30-6:00 p.m.**

*Special events, including on campus and off campus field trips, will be listed in our monthly calendar. Typical events and field trips include games with Mr. Shine, trips to the bowling alley, the local public library and ceramic and pottery workshops, as well as outdoor water play and other age-appropriate physical activities. Students will also attend summer camp activities with the older students when age-appropriate.
