Operations and Facilities Column

The project to return the pool to service, as part of the PE program, continues. The plumbing in the equipment room is complete and the electrical work to connect a variety of new control devices is about 75% complete. The system we are installing is a salt system, replacing the traditional system of adding chlorine and chemicals. A small amount of salt, the same kind that is in a water softener, is added to the pool. The amount of salt in the pool will be quite low, a fraction of what you get in the ocean. The advantages are many (kind to the skin, eyes, hair, swimsuits, etc.). Broomfield Academy will have the first 'public' salt water pool in Broomfield.

There is still quite a lot of work to do to complete the pool project (add system of deck drains, HVAC, more electrical work, concrete, etc.); weekly updates will be included in this section of the Principal's newsletter. Feel free to peak through the windows of the pool, either side, if you are curious. Due to construction, please, no visitors inside the pool building.
