Operations and Facilities Column

The front door closer on the front door to the main school building (along 120th St.) was adjusted to assure that the door closes and locks 100% of the time. This became a problem this past week and was repaired.

Window tint was applied to the windows in the computer room, the front entry hall and the Jr. Kindergarten Explorers room. This will significantly reduce the southern sun glare and temperature in those rooms on warmer days.

The wood around the central skylight, the metal roof jacks and the swamp cooler supports in the main elementary school building, as well as weathered trim around roofline of the 3rd-6th grade rooms was primed and repainted. This weather-related maintenance item also yielded a nice improvement in the appearance when looking at the building from the blacktop and from 120th.

Springs, rollers and other hardware were replaced on the large den door to allow for easier opening and closing.

Other work was related to building utilization planning, various cost estimation projects and some plumbing and boiler work. Regular radon testing was completed and the asbestos management plan (required for all schools in Colorado) was reviewed.
